

Initial Evaluation

Our expert clinical team provides the evaluations needed to determine an accurate diagnosis. This may require a Biopsychosocial and/or an ADOS assessment.

Coordinate Benefits

Our clinic team coordinates benefits for an Initial Behavior Assessment (IBA).

Behavior Assessment

A BCBA observes the child, interviews caregivers, and completes an IBA to determine the intensity of services.

Treatment Options

The BCBA finalizes the IBA report with family input and reviews the assessment and service recommendations with the family.

Assemble Your Team

The Clinical team will submit for authorization and will coordinate a special team of clinicians for each child.

Glossary of Terms

Dosage

The amount of weekly therapy hours prescribed by the clinical team. Proper dosage is critical to making meaningful gains and reaching goals.

IBA

An Initial Behavior Assessment consists of caregiver interviews and child observations/assessments to identify needed skills and targeted behaviors.

Biopsychosocial

This assessment may be part of an initial clinical evaluation to assess biological, psychological, and social factors.

ADOS

The Autism Diagnostic
Observation Schedule involves a series of tasks/observations to assess for features of autism/ASD.
