Send Referral

A brief summary of clinical concerns regarding your patient and what you would like the NeuroGenomics consult to address. The clinical coordinator will respond with recommendations and next steps.

2 Order Testing

The clinical coordinator will provide you with detailed instructions on ordering the genetic testing.

3 Lab Verifies Insurance

Once your office submits the order directly to the lab, the lab will work with your patient's insurance company to verify coverage.

4 Genetic Testing Process

Once there is either an insurance approval or the patient confirms a method of payment with the lab, then the lab will send a saliva kit to the patient's home. The genetic test takes about 12-15 weeks to complete.

5 Prepare Needed Items

Have your office staff send the clinical coordinator the following:

- a. All official laboratory genetic reports to be discussed
- b. Initial and most recent comprehensive note/evaluations
- c. Forms signed by physician "P2P Physician Agreement"
- d. Forms signed by patient: "P2P Patient Consent" + "Patient Forms"
- e. Payment: pay with your office credit card then charge the patient or have the patient call the clinical coordinator directly

6 Schedule P2P Consultation

Once the patient sends their sample to the lab, contact the clinical coordinator to schedule the P2P in advance.

7 Attend P2P Consultation

The clinical coordinator will email a Zoom link. Your patient is welcome and encouraged to attend. Dr. Boles will send you a copy of his report.
