1 Initial Evaluation

A biopsychosocial evaluation is conducted by our psychologist. A child with behavioral, mental or emotional concerns may be referred for ABA therapy.



2 Coordinate Benefits

Our clinic team coordinates benefits for an Initial Behavior Assessment (IBA).



3 Behavior Assessment

A BCBA observes the child, interviews caregivers, and completes an IBA to determine the intensity of services.



4 Treatment Options

The BCBA finalizes the IBA report with family input and reviews the assessment and service recommendations with the family.



5 Assemble Your Team

The Clinical team will submit for authorization and will coordinate a special team of clinicians for each child.
