An appointment with a NeurAbilities developmental pediatrician or neurologist is an important first step in understanding symptoms, including concerns about learning, behaviors, and developmental milestones.



Our psychological services assist in creating treatment plans, formulating goals for individual educational plans (IEP), and monitoring the benefit of interventions. Assessments are customized to meet individual needs.



Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA)

We offer 1-to-1 ABA services in home, center, and community settings, customized to meet the unique needs of each individual patient. Our programs are created with a personalized approach to address a variety of skills and goals. Within each of the following ABA programs, we offer a Young Achievers group specifically designed for young children between the ages of 2 and 5 years old to focus on the development of school readiness skills through individual and group instruction.

Comprehensive ABA

This intensive program provides therapeutic interventions for toddlers 14 months and older that promote generalization of targeted skills. These structured therapy sessions address multiple treatment areas, and typically occupy 25 to 40 hours per week.

Focused ABA

This targeted treatment program is appropriate for school-aged children as young as 3 years old who need services to address a specific skill or acute treatment goal. Recommended for approximately 15 hours per week.
